PACKED LUNCH GUIDANCE

A number of parents have requested advice and guidance on what food is acceptable in packed lunches. Following advice from the Government, we have put together a policy for packed lunch along with a process of ensuring our school remains a Healthy School.

In summary, the four items that will not be acceptable in Packed Lunches from September will be: **solid chocolate** (a single chocolate covered biscuit such as Penguin or Breakaway will be allowed), **fizzy drinks**, **sweets** or items from **Fast Food** outlets.

If a member of staff becomes aware that a child has one or more of these in their lunch they will notify the Chef who will make a note of the child but will not discuss this directly with them. If one of these items is noted for a second time in the same child's lunch, a message will be sent directly to the parent either via email, ParentHub or by sealed note in their child's bookbag. This message will include the Government's Guidance and will notify the parent that if one of the above items is noted for a third time then it will be replaced with a piece of fruit and the item sent home with the child at the end.
