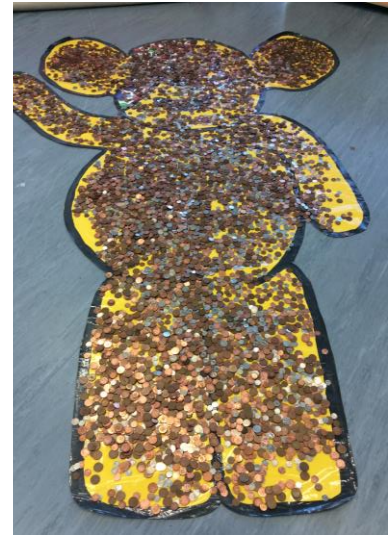
The Lincoln Carlton Academy School Council have been very busy over the last year sharing ideas and discussing school improvements.
