Dear Parents and Carers,

## **Reception Trip to Hall Farm Park**

We are planning to take Reception children to Hall Farm Park on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> May as part of their topic "Animal Magic"!

The children will leave school at 9:15am so please could you ensure your child is at school on time for registration at 8.55am. They will leave Hall Farm Park at 2:30pm to return to school for a usual finish time. They will need to have a warm coat, their usual school uniform top, comfortable trousers and wellies or boots.

There will be a charge of £4.00 for the admission and £5.00 to cover the cost of the coach therefore making a total of £9.00. This amount has been added as a payment item to your Parent Pay account. Please can all children bring sandwiches and a drink, snacks will be provided. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals Pupil Premium a sandwich will be provided.

If you are in receipt of Income Support, Income Based Job Seeking Allowance, support under part V1 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, Child Tax Credit, provided that Working Tax Credit is not also received and the family's income (as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs) does not exceed £16,190 (currently in receipt of Free School Meals). If in receipt of any of the above you could be exempt from making a voluntary contribution.

We would be very grateful for some volunteers to be available to help on the trip – these will be picked at random if there are more volunteers than spaces.
