## Concerns regarding safe crossing and parking around school

- Mrs Malam outlined what the local resident's association (GQRA) have been working on with regards to park & stride and the opposition faced by CO-OP.
- Mrs Malam explained school's request for a school crossing patrol person to provide a safe crossing area for families before the children start in Year 5, and has heard from Pam Streets that a road survey to ascertain the need for a road crossing patrol prior to 2019.
- Mrs Benton has spoken with the Civil Parking Enforcement Officers and supplied them with the key times of day that parents park on the double yellow lines. The number to call if you see someone parking like this is - **01522 511142**.
- A safety zone with the zigzag lines only provides an advisory warning to road users, it is not law enforceable unfortunately. Mrs Malam along with GQRA, do feel that over long term basis, double yellow lines will be more efficient if they are monitored officially as parking restrictions on double yellows are enforceable.
- **Request parents to campaign for a "20's plenty for us" zone throughout the estate.**  
This is already underway with GQRA and along with other safety initiatives, they are working together to campaign for a safer option for the whole estate.

- We also recommend any instances of speeding through the estate are reported straight to the police.
- Could parents come to GQRA meetings that are held either at the school or at Olsen Court?
- LCA will advertise on the newsletter when the next GQRA meeting is due.
- Parents who attended meeting agreed shrubbery on roundabout too high and causes a risk to people trying to see to cross the road and Mrs Malam agreed to notify those responsible for the grounds maintenance
- Parents asked about car park safety – would it be better to close off the small car park from parents and use as disabled car park and staff only Survey parents prior to next year's intake
