Roblox is an online game and app where you can create your own games or play games that other users have made. There's the option to chat to other players, but you can change this to private or friends only. Unfortunately, we know it can be used inappropriately and lead to some children getting upset about messages sent to them from their peers. We take E-safety very seriously and any concerns about inappropriate online use will be reported and logged by staff. Children learn about e-safety in school but we rely on parents to talk with their children about what they are accessing online and ensure suitable parental controls are used.
