Regional Governance Administrator

We are looking for someone who is willing to learn, flexible, hardworking and has a very strong working knowledge of computer programmes particularly word, excel and outlook. The successful candidate will provide governance advice and administrative support for Heads, Governors and other staff members, ensuring statutory requirements are fulfilled and will act as a central point of contact.
