ABSENCE REPORTING

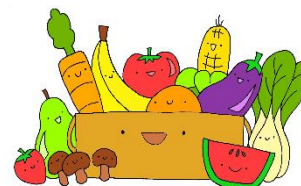
We are always looking for 100% attendance and aim to achieve great attendance results, however we do understand days off due to illness or injuries are sometimes unavoidable.
